

## BJGA 2011/2012 Season Structure

### Novice Players Membership

The novice group is for those who are new to the game of golf. These participants will benefit from being exposed to the basic fundamentals of the game. The series is comprised of regularly scheduled lessons on Saturdays. All sessions will be carried out at Ocean View driving range and lessons will last for one hour. The novices will cover all facets of the game including etiquette and a basic introduction to the rules of golf. Participants will also have opportunities to play at Fairmont Princess and Ocean View throughout the season. These opportunities will be 9-hole, 2-person captain's choice events.



*Promotion to intermediate is based on the recommendation of a golfing professional and/or the BJGA board. Ultimately, the board will make the final decision.*

- Membership fee is \$25/season
- Weekly group lessons
- 2-person captain's choice series

### Intermediate Players Membership

The intermediate series is for those juniors who can hit a golf ball consistently but may not be ready for 18-holes on a larger course. The weekly series will be composed of 9 or 18-hole individual stroke-play events. Participants will play for merit points at each event. Caddies are allowed to carry clubs, but cannot offer advice to players on the course. To qualify for this series, participants must provide a signed recommendation from a local golf professional or be approved by the board of directors. Each week a maximum of 24 participants can play. Play will be governed by the Royal & Ancient Rules of Golf.



*Top finishers at the end of the season will be eligible for promotion into TP golf. Participants may also become eligible for early promotion after 4 first-place finishes in the weekly events.*

- Membership fee is \$100/season
- Vouchers for golf lessons
- Weekly tournament series

## Tournament Players Membership

The TP series will consist of regularly scheduled 18-hole events on Saturdays. The majority of these events will be stroke-play, although additional formats are played during the season. Each month a medal round is played for monthly medal points, with points accumulating through the course of the season. At the end of the season the point leaders from each group will be recognized for their achievement.

Participants in the “blue” and “white” tee groups will have an opportunity to play all of the major courses on the island. No caddies are allowed in the weekly events.

To qualify for this series, participants must have an official handicap or be approved by the board of directors. Play will be governed by the Royal & Ancient Rules of Golf.

- Membership fee is \$250/season
- Vouchers for golf lessons (red tee players)
- Weekly group lessons (white & blue tee players)
- Weekly tournament series
