

Monthly Medal format guidelines

Players:

Play will be governed by The Rules of Golf as approved by The Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, Scotland and then local rules of the course along with BJGA rules as dictated in the Code of Conduct.

- There are no max strokes per hole unless a tournament official states otherwise. All holes are played out.
- Rules queries affecting play should be brought to the attention of the Official in Charge. If in doubt during play, proceed under Rule 3-3, "Doubt as to Procedure", i.e., "play a second ball" and report details to the designated marshal, prior to signing the card.
- For each tee group – points are awarded as follows:
1st – 10, 2nd – 8, 3rd – 6, 4th – 4, 5th – 2
- Ties are decided by retrogression using the match last nine holes, last six, last three, and then the 18th hole.

A maximum of **7** monthly medal rounds will be totaled for each player during the season. The top three finishers in each tee group will be awarded prizes.

Spectators:

Parents / spectators are encouraged to come out and support the players. Spectators should maintain proper distance from all players, preferably by walking on the cart path.

Examples of behavior not allowed (non-inclusive list):

- Interfering with the normal pace of play
- Tending the pin
- Giving advice during hole play
- Providing rule help
- No caddying – no assistance with equipment
- No forecaddying - spectators must stay with or behind the players
- Noise to be kept to a minimum, with consideration being given to all players, not just the participant he/she is supporting.
- Cannot follow players in a golf cart unless approved by tournament official

Examples of behavior allowed (non-inclusive list):

- Help maintain the pace of play
- Help look for lost balls for all players, not just the player you are supporting. Players should get in the habit of asking for help.
- Report to the marshal inappropriate behavior
- Provide food or drink
