Re: **Tee time cancellation policy**

The BJGA must reserve in advance a block of tee times from the various golf courses on the island in order to facilitate Saturday play each week. The Board and volunteers work very hard to maintain a good relationship with the clubs in order to acquire these tee times. In some cases, the BJGA is required to pay for any tee times not released back to the club by the Thursday prior to play. This is why we request you submit a weekly tee time reservation by Wednesday evening.

If you must cancel a reservation, the cancellation procedure up thru Friday evening is to call the posted Starter or send an email to [info@juniorgolf.bm](mailto:info@juniorgolf.bm). For a Saturday cancellation, you must contact the posted Starter and get confirmation. It is your responsibility to ensure your reservation has been cancelled as we may have other members on a wait-list to play. The BJGA policy and procedures states that failure to give notice of a cancellation can result in a disqualification to play the following Saturday. The policy and procedures also states that the BJGA reserves the right to pass on cancellation costs to the member in the event of short or no notice.

The Board recognizes there are circumstances which require a cancellation. These include illness, family crisis, etc., and no penalties are assessed. However, there have been an usually large number of cancellations on the previous two Saturdays that are not in this category. Many of these occurred on Saturday morning and sometimes a few minutes before their scheduled tee time. The Board has discussed the issue and will start assessing the penalties described about if this trend continues. We prefer you do not make a reservation before-hand if you have other Saturday activities that might interfere with golf. You can always call the Starter to see if a tee time is available once you confirm you have the time available to play.
