As announced at Registration, a group of 12 Boys from the Tonbridge School in Tonbridge Wells, England will be touring Bermuda the week of the PGA Grand Slam, arriving Friday, 15 October. (<http://www.tonbridge-school.co.uk>)

To keep costs down for their Tour, the school is hoping that the members of the BJGA can host their 12 boys for 3 nights - Friday, 15 October through Sunday, 17 October. While the school would prefer to house their boys in pairs, they recognize that singles would be more likely. The boys range in age from 14 to 17. While this Tour is for golfers, the school requires that the Tour has a cultural component, and staying with host families is a great way to learn about life in Bermuda.

Obligations of Host Family -

Friday Evening - collect boy(s) from the BA flight(6:20pm arrival); dinner with host family

Saturday Morning - spend with the host family.

Saturday Afternoon- take to Riddell's Bay for Monthly medal. Dinner will be provided for all competitors and their families(including host families) after the round;

Saturday Evening – spend with your family.

Sunday Morning - spend with host family.

Saturday Afternoon - take to Belmont for match with BJGA (tee times at 12:00);

Saturday Evening – spend with host family, including dinner time (no food provided after Belmont match)

Monday Morning - drop students at Port Royal for Grand Slam volunteering (with luggage).
