Press Release:

A crowded leader board sets up an exciting finish for tomorrow's final round at Port Royal in the RBT Junior International Classic. A total of 27 participants are competing in the 54 hole tournament with countries such as United Kingdom, USA and Bermuda all being represented.

16-18 Division - Gross

Julien Papadopoulo continues his excellent play posting a 6 over 76 in his second round at Rosewood Tucker's Point giving him a two day total of 12 over, 153 and a one shot lead over Ryan Roberts who added an 8 over 78 to take his total to 154, 13 over par. Scott Gilbertson fired the best round of the day with a 4 over 74 pulling himself right back into the tournament leaving him in 3rd place at 16 over, 157. Mitchell Campbell is in fourth and Dwayne Pearman Jr. is in 5th, all realistically having a chance tomorrow as Port Royal will be a true test of golf.

16-18 Division - Net

Dwayne Pearman Jr. continues to lead the net division at 3 over 144 and a one shot lead over Julien Papadopoulo who is on 4 over, 145.

13-15 Division – Gross

Arriek Douglas, Bermuda takes a slim one shot lead going into the final round tomorrow after posting an 83 in his second round giving him a two day total of 165, 24 over par. In second place from the USA is Justin Stagg who recorded the best score in his age group for the day, a 7 over 77 and a two day total of 166 and 25 over par joint second Cameron Chottiner also from the USA. Cameron posted an 86 in his second round.

13-15 Division – Net

Arriek Douglas, Bermuda continues to lead in the net division after a net 70 today giving him a two day total of 3 under par 138 overall. In second place is Kyle Trott from Bermuda on 2 under 139.

Boys 12 & Under

Normally a 5 shot lead will be considered comfortable however tomorrow's final round at Port Royal can certainly change the leader board. Thomas Allkins posted an impressive 7 over 77 giving him a two day total of 161, 25 over par and the lead going into tomorrow's round. Andrew DiPetrillo from the US is in second place after his 77 today put him at 166, 25 over par.

Girls Open Division

Sophie DiPetrillo from USA takes a commanding lead in the Girls Open division after recording an 83 today giving her a two day total of 170, 29 over par. Tied for 2nd place on 184 is Elizabeth Parsons, Bermuda and Chloe DiPetrillo from the USA.

The tournament concludes tomorrow at the home of the PGA Grand Slam, Port Royal with the leaders going out last at 10:04am. First tee time is at 9am.
