

Turkey Shoot and Player Development Clinic

Saturday 10 December – Rosewood Tucker's Point Golf Club

Turkey Shoot – Tee times 9:45 to 11:42 a.m.

15 tee times, for 30 teams

Format – Captains Choice (25% of combined handicap)

Red group player teams will be teeing off first (approx 9:45-10:40) in order to allow for the clinic for white and blue groups.

Their rounds will be followed by a clinic with Henry Brunton at the Rosewood Tucker's Point practice facilities.

All white and blue group players are invited to a clinic with Henry Brunton at the Rosewood Tucker's Point Golf Club practice facilities. **The clinic will start promptly at 9:15.**

Immediately following the clinic with Mr. Brunton, the white and blue group players will then tee off in their groups for the turkey shoot, starting at approximately 10:45 am.

All tee times above are dependent on the number of teams which sign up in each category.

Prize Giving – lower veranda outside pro-shop – approx. 4:00 pm

After the prize giving Rosewood Tucker's Point have kindly offered to host drinks and Question and Answer Session (adults only) in the Rosewood Tucker's Point Golf Club bar for those parents who would like to ask questions of Henry.

Player Development Clinics

Henry Brunton, former Canada National team golf coach, will in Bermuda to work with the BGA and BJGA on the development of a long term player development program for Bermuda golf.

This is part of the player development initiative which is being developed by Craig Brown (VP, BGA, and TPI Certified Instructor) and Paul Adams (Director Golf, Rosewood Tucker's Point Club, and TPI Certified Instructor), in conjunction with the Bermuda Golf Association and Bermuda Junior Golf Association.

All players who are part of the BJGA program are invited to attend one of the clinics that Henry will be holding at the times below:

White and Blue Groups – 9:15 – 10:45 am approx

Red (18 and 9 hole) Groups – 3 – 4:15 pm approx

Between the clinics Henry will be touring the course to watch the juniors play, and converse with them on strategy etc.

Parent Question and Answer Session – Approx. 4:15 pm onwards

Turkey Shoot Event Details

Teams are 1 junior and 1 senior (age 18+) player.

Fee is \$75 payable at registration time. Please arrive at the course no later than: -

- **White and Blue Group** – 9:05 am to allow clinic to start promptly
- **Red Group** – at least **30 minutes prior to your tee-time**

Tee times will be in Royal Gazette on Friday before the tournament and **posted on the website.**

Handicaps – Juniors will use their handicap as of Dec 1st as posted on the website (even if their handicap is provisional). Seniors will use their established handicap. The maximum handicap is set at 24 for men and 36 for women and juniors. Any person (Junior or Senior) who doesn't have a handicap will play off the maximum. Play will be off 25% of combined handicap.

Tees – Juniors play from their Saturday tournament tees. Men play from blue tees. Women play from red tees.

Food and Prizes – Prize vouchers towards a turkey or ham from Supermart will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishers. A special prize from Craig Brown will also go to the winning team.

Henry Brunton ([Web Site](#))

Henry Brunton is one of the most recognizable names in Canadian golf and is one of the world's leading golf coaches and educators. He is the creator of the Canadian PGA's Teaching and Coaching Certification program, a CPGA Master Professional and the only Canadian listed among GOLF Magazine's Top 100 Teachers in America.

In 2005, Brunton was the first, and only, Canadian recognized by GOLF Magazine as one of America's "Top 100 Teachers," the publication's survey of teaching excellence. In 2008 he became the first Canadian to be included among the U.S. Kids Golf Top 50 Junior Teachers list. In 2009, he was named National Junior Leader of the Year by the Canadian PGA. In 2010, Brunton was the first Canadian recognized by the PGA's of Europe - an alliance of PGA's of 37 countries with its most prestigious honour - the Five Star Professional Award.
