Subject: **DNF and NC scorecards**

Dear Members,

The Operations Committee hopes that you all are enjoying participating in junior golf events. This season has gone relatively smoothly thus far. As you may have noticed we are getting some additional play at the private courses on the island for which we are very grateful.

On another matter, the Operations Committee has seen an increase in the number of did not finish (DNF) and no-cards (NC) being turned in at the end of Saturday play. This disturbs us quite a bit. We understand that sometimes, unforeseeable circumstances may arise that may cause a player not to finish a round or turn in an incomplete score card. We are bothered by the potential of players intentionally submitting DNFs and NCs for handicap reasons. Therefore, in the future, if a case arises where you are not able to turn in a completed score card, you will be required to inform the marshal for the respective event and provide a reason for not finishing the round.

If a marshal is not informed or the reason given is not suitable, a player can be issued a yellow card. Acceptable reasons include injury or sickness (e.g., asthma flare ups). Playing badly is not an acceptable reason to cut short a round.
